REFUND POLICY

Tactical Medics Group was established in 2012. We quickly identified the need to provide better education for those who wanted to know more about combat medicine. Items that YOU as a student will open and apply during scenarios. These are the same supplies or items that you would buy to put in your personal IFAK kits. I can say that no one likes to use used bandages or use improvised chest seals in training, you will use the real deal!

OUR REFUND POLICY IS AS FOLLOWS
